**Pal chin kaisehun kal na piya bina, jaya kaho kou Shyamsundar sana.**

Let someone inform my Beloved that without Him  
I can't enjoy any peace even for a single moment.

**उठति करेजे हूक छिनहिं छिन, पिय हिय तरस न, हम लागीं तरसन ।**

**Uthati kareje huka chinahin china, Piya hiya tarasa na, ham lagin tarsana.**

I feel a frequent sweet pain of longing in my heart. I have been longing for Him like this, but my Beloved's heart does not know any mercy.

**परसों आवन कहि गये अबहूँ, आये न, बीत गये सखि बरसन ।**

**Parason avan kahi gaye abahun, aye na, bita gaye sakhi barsana.**

He promised to come back in two days,  
but years have passed and He has not come.

**प्रान पयान करत नहिं, नैनन यह आशा पिय देइहैं दरसन ।**

**Pran payana karat nahin, nainan, yah asha Piya daihain darsana.**

In the pain of separation, my life breath wants to leave my body,  
but the hope of my eyes does not allow it to go.

**अब 'कृपालु' भरि अंक मिलो, या, निज-कर देह चलाय सुदर्शन ॥**
